



Welcome to the new Fraser Coast Presenter Weather readout. Our goal was to produce a consistent weather readout that is brief yet comprehensive and accurate.

It had to be something everyone can use without complexity and one that needs no intervention and little or no interpretation by the Presenter.

It needed to be simple, easy to use, up to the minute, accurate and automated.

This system completely replaces the BOM forecast readouts and any other weather information source you may have been using previously.

We would like all presenters to use this new system exclusively.

The script in its simplest form just simply needs to be read out verbatim to produce a credible, well presented weather report.


The Script will automatically update itself with the latest weather every 30 minutes. No user input is required, you don't even need to refresh the screen.

First things first, how do you find it?

On any [frasercoast.fm](http://frasercoast.fm) web page simply click on the **Weather Wall** button on the top right of the screen.



Then scroll down the page and click the "Presenter Weather Page" link



The Weather Script page will pop up on your screen.

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Now here is the current weather:

In Hervey Bay today we have a 55% chance of rain, The wind is expected to be from the S at 24km/h with daytime temperatures from 17 to a maximum of 27. It is currently 26.7 degrees and the wind is 24 kph.

The UV Index today is Very High so don't forget that sunblock!

Tomorrow in Hervey Bay the forecast is for a 40% chance of rain, we expect a minimum overnight of 19 degrees with a maximum of 27 and the winds are expected to be from the S at 19 kph.

In Maryborough and the Wide Bay District today it's Partly cloudy. Medium (40%) chance of showers along the coastal fringe, near zero chance elsewhere. Winds SE 15 to 20 km/h becoming light in the evening. Daytime maximum temperatures in the mid to high 20s. It is currently 28.0 degrees.

Tomorrow in Maryborough there is a 50% chance of rain with a minimum temperature of 18 degrees and a maximum of 29, the winds are expected to be from the S at 17 kph.

The forecast for Hervey Bay Waters on Wednesday: Southerly 10/15 knots, becoming southeasterly 15/20 knots in the middle of the day. Seas: 1/1.5 metres. Swell: North to northeasterly below 1 metre. Thursday: Southeasterly 15/20 knots. Seas: 1/1.5 metres. Swell: North to northeasterly below 1 metre.

The next Low Tide is forecast to be 0.73 meters at 3:23 pm and the next High Tide is forecast to be 3.56 meters at 9:36 pm.

That's the latest weather.

Now, there are several options for you, depending on how you personally prefer to do things.

1. You can choose to simply read the weather right off the screen. The second monitor in the studio works well for this purpose.
2. If you would rather read the script from a printed copy, then just click on the "**Print Forecast**" link and the script will be printed on the printer just outside the studio door.



3. Alternately you can ask one of the office assistants to print off the script for you out in the office.
4. If you do choose the Print option then **remember to print a new copy for each weather readout** as the information is updated automatically every 30 minutes and **the new forecast may be different from the one you read last time.**

Either way you choose, the script will always be ready to read and contain accurate up to the minute weather.

Hope you enjoy this much simpler, consistent and accurate way of presenting the weather.
