

HEALTH STATEMENT FOR VOLUNTEERS

Duty of Care to our volunteers and Workplace Health and Safety responsibilities are of prime importance to our organisation.

In regard to this, FM107.5 needs to know of any chronic, or long term, mental or physical health issues which may impact either on your ability to carry out tasks without special consideration, outside the usual performance of tasks.

In all instances, FM107.5 will ascertain the organisation’s capacity to provide necessary support, whether in human resources or in the physical environment of the Station.

Such conditions could include epilepsy, cardio-vascular complaints, respiratory problems, serious allergies that may occur when in the studio, mobility, chronic pain, advanced terminal disease, prostheses, mental illnesses or personality disorders such as chronic depression, Bipolar Syndrome, Autism Spectrum Disorder, drug or alcohol addiction/problems.

If you have suffered from any such conditions in the past, or are still suffering from them, we request that you disclose this in the interest of our Duty of Care and Workplace Health and Safety responsibilities. This information will remain strictly confidential apart from any requirements for emergency actions to be taken if needed.
